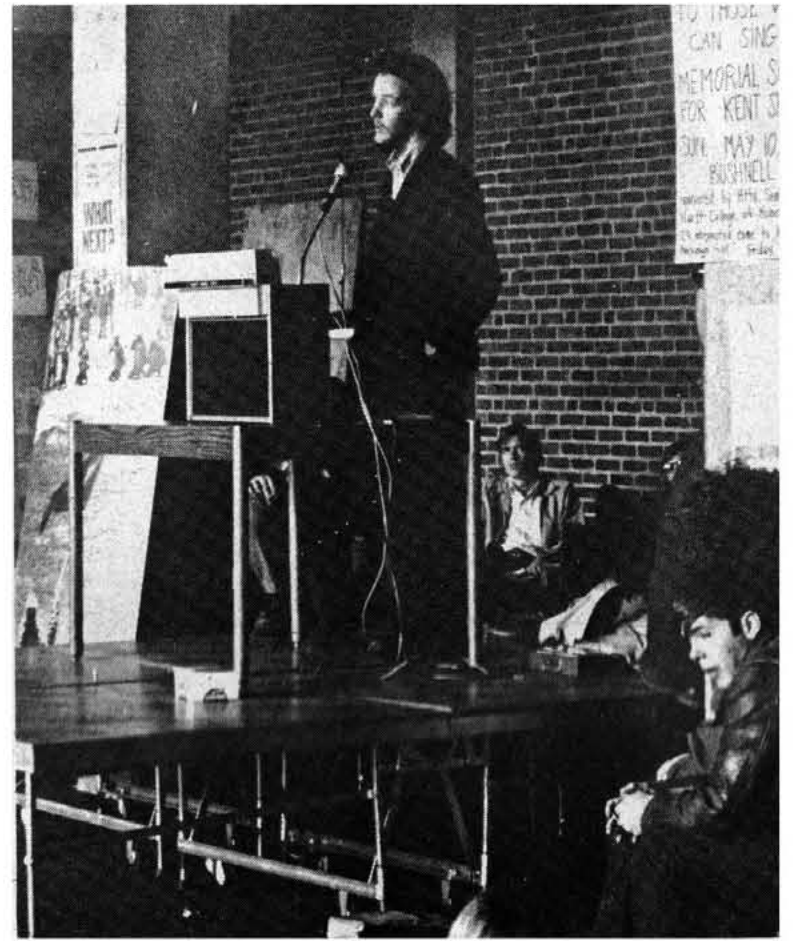












Tuesday - May 12th
